

## INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY/LIBRARY & INFORMATION STUDIES

Professionals who work with information, acquire, analyze, organize, store, preserve, and disseminate data in order to create and maintain personal and organizational connections. At the undergraduate level, they may hold a bachelor's degree in Information Technology; at the graduate level, they may hold a master's degree or specialist degree in Library and Information Studies or a doctor of philosophy degree in Information Studies.
