

NONPROFIT CAREERS

The term nonprofit applies to organizations that do not retain profit. They are often designed to carry out good work, advocate, or pursue a cause. There are voluntary as well as well paid positions available within nonprofit organizations. Whether concentrating in research/education, assistance/relief, youth services, or health care, nonprofits are labor intensive (services, not goods, are their output). Federal organization are sometimes grouped as nonprofit while organizations which are organized and funded independent of the government are called NGO's (Nongovernmental organizations).
